

WIN A CLEAN UP CREW

TERMS & CONDITIONS

GENERAL

This competition is conducted by Benedict Recycling Pty Ltd (ABN 71 123 156 507)– ‘The Promoters’

Entry into this competition deems acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other reference to this competition, these Terms and Conditions will prevail.

‘The Promoters’ reserve the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time.

‘The Promoters’ may also cancel or suspend this competition if an event beyond the control of ‘the Promoters’ corrupts or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, safety or proper conduct of this competition.

‘The Promoters’ will disqualify any individual who has tampered with the entry process or any other aspect of this competition.

All participants agree to be contacted by Benedict Recycling via email for further marketing purposes.

PRIZE

There will be one winner selected –drawn from entrants domiciled within a 20km radius of Benedict Recycling Mayfield West (1a McIntosh Dr).

The winner will receive one prize consisting of a Benedict Clean Up Crew attending the private premises of the winner and facilitating the removal of 2.2 tonne (or 8M³) of dry household or builders waste free of charge. The waste will be removed by trailer with a maximum capacity of 1.1 tonne per load, being up to 2 loads maximum.

The winner will receive a signed and framed 2019 Newcastle Knights jersey, to be presented to the winner at the Newcastle Knights Headquarters, 32 Industrial Drive Mayfield NSW 2320 on the date and time specified by Benedict Recycling and the Newcastle Knights. This signed jersey is not for resale and can not be substituted for cash or another prize.

Waste must be photographed for submission and must fall under the acceptable waste guidelines for Benedict Recycling Centres. Please note that we cannot accept hazardous waste, putrescible waste or asbestos. Requirements for eligibility:

- i. The entrant must own or have the legal right to dispose of the waste.
- ii. The entrant must own or have the legal right to access the premises where the waste is to be collected from. Benedict reserves the right to refuse to enter any property where legal or safe access is in doubt.

- iii. Reasonable and safe site access must be available for the Benedict Clean Up Crew to enter and drive an 8x5 box trailer within 3 metres of the waste to be collected.
- iv. Waste must be assessed as acceptable by the Benedict Clean up Crew. Benedict reserves the right to refuse waste that is prohibited.
- v. Waste must be collected at Benedict's discretion, midweek between 7am-4pm.
- vi. The winner must be available at a time selected by the Knights to be presented with the signed jersey. If an agreed time between all parties can not be facilitated within one month of the Clean up Crew attendance date, and alternate time will be co-ordinated by Benedict Recycling and the winner to collect the prize from Benedict Recycling's Mayfield Depot.

WHO CAN ENTER?

Entry is free, and is open to any persons over 18 years of age and residing within 20km Benedict Recycling Mayfield West.

It is open to households, community or not for profit groups.

It is not open to commercial or industrial incorporated businesses.

Photographs of waste must not be digitally manipulated. Photos must clearly show all waste to be disposed of.

All details provided by the entrant must be true and accurate.

Only one entrant per premise.

Where there is an identifiable person in an image submitted, the entrant is responsible for obtaining a signed Model Release to provide to 'the Promoters' if requested.

No responsibility is accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries.

'The Promoters' reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual who 'the Promoters' have reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful

or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the promotion. 'The Promoters' legal rights to recover damages or other compensation are reserved
